KIM KRIVDA

Mayor Gresock reported DCI's storm water management ends at that catch basin and they own the storm system with the detention pond. Mrs. Krivda questioned whether it stops at the fence and Mayor Gresock stated it stops at the inlet and that is where their ownership terminates. He reported the property from the inlet to Jamison is not owned by DCI but they cleaned it out from their pond to Jamison since the last meeting. Mrs. Krivda inquired whether it is no longer clogged and Mr. Hugus reported they submitted a report indicating they cleaned it from the detention basin to the street.
